Importance of Risk Assessments

Our Educators must complete a Risk Assessment for every venue / location they visit whilst children are in their care. These documents are crucial for compliance & safety purposes, so if you haven't viewed a Risk Assessment for a location you know your Educator visits while your child is in care, please ask them to view this document and ensure you have signed off, if you approve, on the parent authority for excursion form.

Communicable Diseases Update

The <u>Communicable Disease guidelines</u> have been updated. The purpose of the booklet is to help to prevent and control the spread of infections in the community. Further information on the management of a range of common childhood infections and strategies for preventing their transmission can be obtained from *Staying Healthy in Childcare*.

Parent Gap Payments

As of 1st July 2023, all parent gap payments must be taken by EFT, no cash payments are to be accepted. This is a ruling implemented by the Federal Government to alleviate non-compliance. If you are not already paying your Educator via an EFT method, please speak to them to discuss how you will make payments to them prior to or as of this date.
